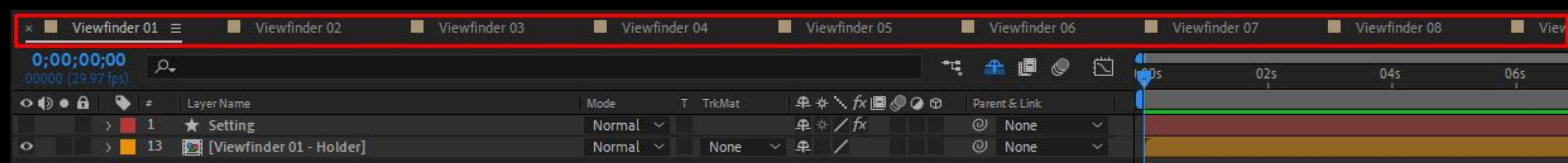
HOW TO USE

1- Unzip the downloaded zipped file.

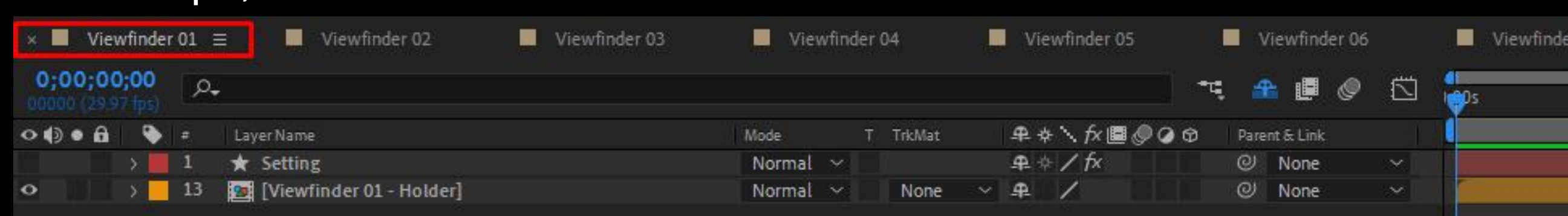
2- Open After effects.

3- Import the selected Ae File to the **Project Panel**.

4- Above the Timeline panel, you can see the **Composition Tabs**, here you can switch between all opened comps.



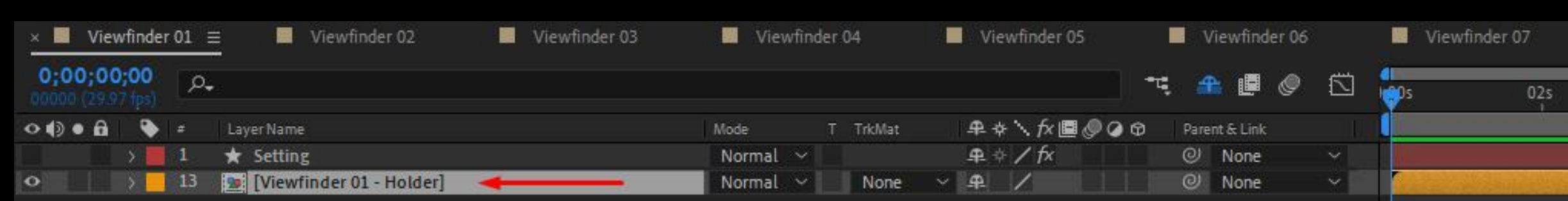
5-For example, click on Viewfinder 1 to show its contents.



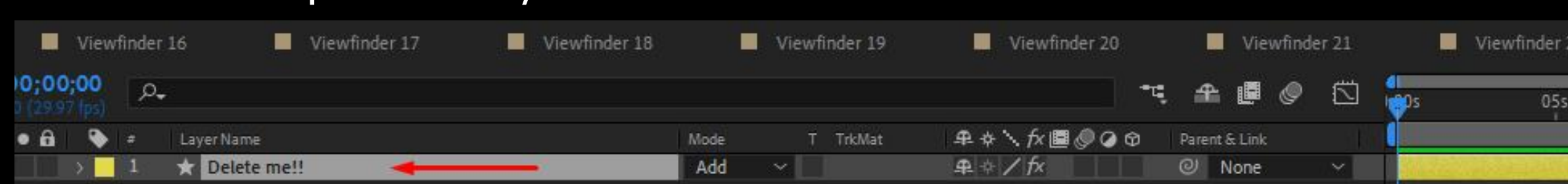
6- Add Your Footage!

● Place your footage in the **Footage Holder** comps.

● First, import your footage into the Project panel, then open the Footage Holder comp and drag your footage into the timeline!



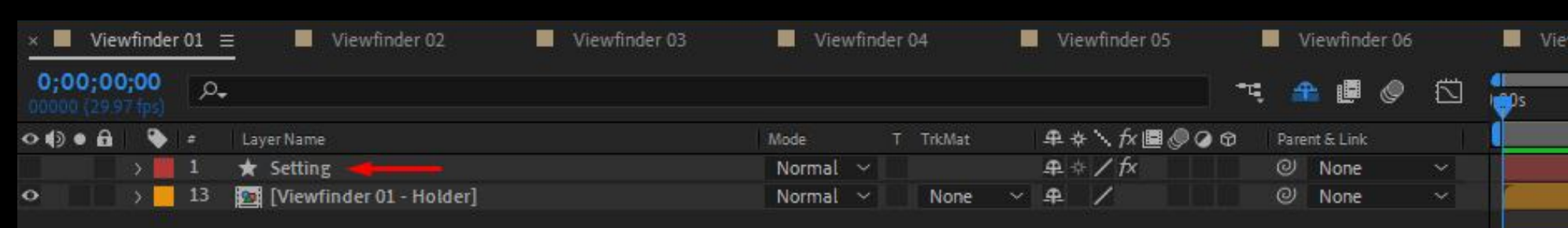
● Delete the “Replace Me” layer from the timeline.



● Then, return to the main “Viewfinder ” comp to see the Viewfinder on your footage.

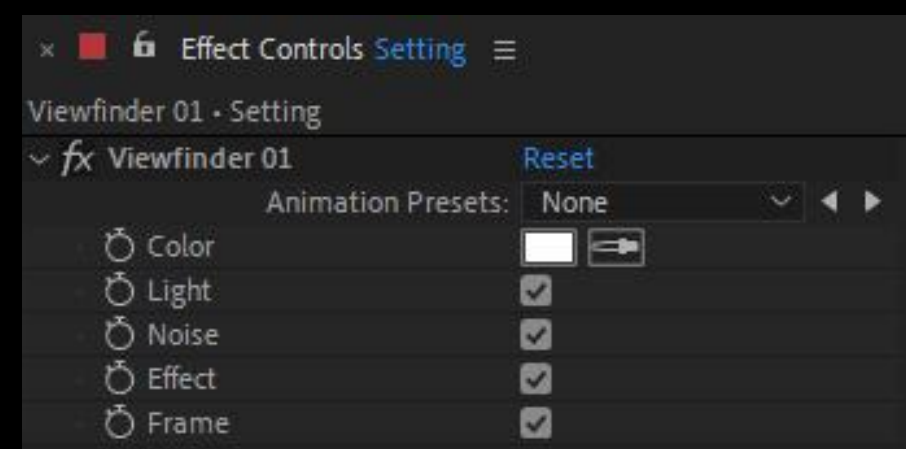
7. Change Project Setting

● In the Timeline, look for the layer named: **Setting**



● Select the layer.

● Open **Effect Controls**: Press (**F3** on keyboard).



● Click the color box and pick your desired color.

● The new color will automatically update throughout the project.

● You can enable or disable the Effects & frame options from the Effect Controls panel.

8. Edit Text

● In the Timeline, look for text layers (with the T icon).

● Double-click the text layer and type your own text directly in the composition.

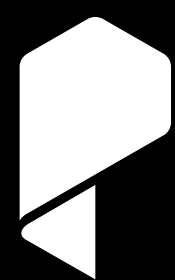
● Use the Character Panel to change font, size, color, or alignment.
